Checklist for MRV

- Objectives of the MRV approach are defined.
- Effects of the NAMA are identified (cause-impact-chain).
- Scope of the MRV approach is set (assessment boundaries) and MRV methodology defined.
- Data needs and collection methods have been identified and agreed by relevant stakeholders.
- Responsibilities for MRV have been assigned.
- A monitoring plan has been developed.
- Baseline emissions have been estimated and assumptions are agreed upon among relevant stakeholders.
- GHG Impact of the NAMA has been calculated (ex-ante or ex-post).
- Limitations of the GHG emission quantification are described (uncertainties).
- Sustainability benefits and process indicators have been assessed.
- Contents and procedures for reporting to the UNFCCC (and donors if applicable) are in place.
- Supporting information to verify the GHG impact can be provided.
